Those who have failed but are confident about a positive result can apply for reevaluation. Save a Year (SAY) examination would be conducted on Feb 26 (India) and Feb 24 (Gulf) is also open to all who were not able pass. In addition to that, those who have failed in 10th class will have another option to secure a just pass by writing an assignment on the following two topics:

1. The Holy Trinity with a special note on Jesus Christ
2. Orthodox Christian Worship

Total pages of this handwritten assignment will be around fourteen pages. Both the topics should be covered in it. The students have to write this by hand and submit it to your Sunday School HM on or before Feb 26th, 2017. But this option is only for the students who have not cleared their tenth class exam. Those who opt this need not write SAY exam. Those who failed but would like to secure a higher grade are encouraged to write SAY exam only. Sunday School HMs are requested to send the exam papers and assignments to the OKR office as early as possible.
